

Pedal Play Mobile Bike Rodeo is back on June 4th

Pedal Play Mobile Bike Rodeo is a fun, one-day event in which participants will learn safe cycling routes and skills in the Kanata North area. This free event is planned for **Sunday, June 4th, 2017, from 1 to 5 pm in Kanata North.**

Small groups of children (6+), youth, and adults will cycle along a pre-determined route and participate in fun interactive 'safety activity' stations along the way. The 6-km route starts and ends in Beaverbrook at W. Erskine Johnston Public School with stops at Ecole St. Remi, the Beaverpond, and All Saints Catholic High School.

The route demonstrates safe routes throughout the community, connecting schools, parks, and community centres. Participants will learn a wide range of skills including how to use hand signals, how to share multiuse paths, how to change gears when climbing a hill, and how to safely navigate roundabouts and crossovers. They will also learn how to confirm their helmet fit and how to do a basic bike maintenance check.

Pedal Play is hosted by the Kanata Beaverbrook Community Association, and organized by Councillor Wilkinson's office, Transportation Action Committee Kanata North (TACK), and EnviroCentre's Sustain Kanata North.
